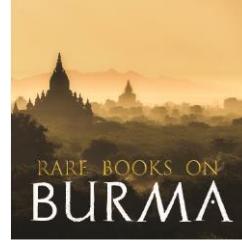


FACT SHEET

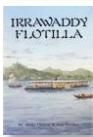

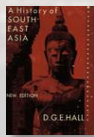

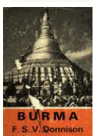
